MINI-OPEN SHOW CLASSES

- **Class 1 Any Variety Livebearing fish.**
- Class 2 Any Variety Cichlid.
- Class 3 Any Variety Coldwater (including Goldfish).
- Class 4 Any Variety Characin*.
- Class 5 Corydoradinae (Corydoras, Aspidoras, Brochis, Scleromystax).
- Class 6 AOV Catfish.
- Class 7 Any Variety Barb, Danio, Rasbora, Minnow.
- Class 8 Any Variety Labyrinth Fish (including Snakeheads, *Badis*, *Dario*).
- Class 9 Any Variety Shark, Fox, Loach.

Class 10- Any tropical freshwater fish not covered in the previous classes.

Class 11 - Junior Class - Any Variety Tropical Freshwater fish. See Mini-Show Rules for terms of entry.

Class 12 - Junior Class - Any Variety Coldwater fish. . See Mini-Show Rules for terms of entry.

Please note that Y.A.A.S. Standards, rules and fish sizes apply to ALL 12 Classes.

Entry fee will be 30p per exhibit. Benching from 9.45 a.m to 11.45 a.m. Judging to begin at 12.00 noon.

Prizes and cards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in all Classes.



*We are pleased to announce that the the 1st placed fish in the Characin Class will be presented with the Mr. Paul Barrow Memorial Trophy. The owner of the winning fish is welcome to take the Trophy home until such time as we announce our next Open Show.

MINI-SHOW RULES

1.Judging to Y.A.A.S. rules and standards. All exhibits to be shown in slab sided containers. All show tanks to have sufficient airspace above the waterline.

2. Terms of entry for Classes 11 and 12. Please note that these two Classes are for Junior fishkeepers only, therefore entrants must be <u>under the age of 16 years old</u>. Entries will not be accepted unless the Junior shower, in whose name the entries are made, is present at the event. The Junior Shower must register their entries themselves and not as part of a family grouping of entries.

3. Once benched, exhibits are not to be removed without the permission of the show steward. When de-benching is announced, all exhibitors should remain within the show room until it is established that no exhibits are missing.

4. To assist the public, exhibitors must name their entries.

5. Although Ryedale Aquarist Society. will take all possible care of exhibits, no responsibility can be accepted for loss of, or damage to, exhibits. Non-exhibitors must gain permission from a Show Steward to take photographs (flash photography is prohibited prior to and during judging) within the showing room. Members of the Ryedale A.S. will be present within the showing area at all times.

The Sales Tables and Information Tables will be open to to general public from 9.45 a.m. to 2.30 p.m.

Sales Tables for the selling of tropical freshwater & coldwater fish and all types of aquatic goods only. Please place the name, either scientific and/or common, of any fish to be sold onto the relevant container or plastic bag.

The venue is ideal for a family day out as it is less than a five-minute walk away from the Town Centre/North York Moors Railway, a ten-minute walk from the famous Parish Church frescos and a fifteen-minute walk from the Norman Castle (which was recently voted the third best Castle in Yorkshire).

HOW TO FIND THE VENUE

From the NORTH EAST AND CUMBRIA

From Thirsk (A1 or A19) or Stokesley make your way to Helmsley. At the roundabout follow the A170 signs for Pickering. At Kirkbymoorside go straight across the roundabout and then follow the A170 all the way until you exit Middleton Village. As you pass the garage (on your right) turn left onto the road which says Local Traffic only. Follow this road until you see the Junior School on your left-hand side. Follow the bend round onto Potter Hill. Pass the Catholic Church on your left and the Memorial Hall is the large building in front of you.

From WHITBY - Follow the A169 into Pickering. Going past the cemetery, carry straight on to the roundabout and take the third exit. As you approach the traffic lights (Lidl is on your left) you need to be in the right-hand lane. Turn right onto Ropery Road (Library on your left) and then turn first left. Go over the bridge. The Memorial Hall is on your left.

From WEST YORKSHIRE, SOUTH YORKSHIRE, LANCASHIRE, THE SOUTH etc. From Tadcaster, follow the A64 onto the Malton by-pass. Branch left at signs for Flamingo Land and Steam Railway. At the roundabout take the 1st exit onto the A169. At the next roundabout take the second exit. Follow the A169 into Pickering. At the roundabout turn left. As you approach the traffic lights (Lidl is on your left) you need to be in the right-hand lane. Turn right onto Ropery Road (Library on your left) and then turn first left. Go over the bridge. The Memorial Hall is on your left.

SCARBOROUGH, BRIDLINGTON - Follow the A170 into Pickering. At the roundabout take the second exit. As you approach the traffic lights (Lidl is on your left) you need to be in the right-hand lane. Turn right onto Ropery Road (Library on your left) and then turn first left. Go over the bridge. The Memorial Hall is on your left.

From HUMBER BRIDGE, DRIFFIELD, HULL etc. - Follow the B1248 into Norton. Go straight on at the first roundabout and turn right at the second. Turn right at the next roundabout and follow the road out of Norton. Go straight on at the traffic lights (The Industrial Park is on the right.) At the roundabout take the first exit onto the A64. Take the next exit off the A64 signposted Pickering/ Malton. Go into the right- hand lane and turn right at the roundabout for theA169 Pickering. At the next roundabout take the second exit. Follow the A169 into Pickering. At the Forest and Vale roundabout turn left. As you approach the traffic lights (Lidl is on your left) you need to be in the right-hand lane. Turn left onto Ropery Road (Library on your left) and then turn first left. Go over the bridge. The Memorial Hall is on your left.
